



Additional Testing May Be Performed

When our Doctors see something in your exam that may be a cause of concern, they look further into the possible issue so that they can treat or diagnose you properly. Therefore, you may come in for what you feel is a routine exam but may need additional tests. These tests are only billable to your medical insurance company, so if you came to us using your routine vision insurance, these tests will not be covered by this insurance. In addition, some medical insurances may either require that you get a referral up front, require you to pay an additional co-pay or in some cases they may go to your deductible.

Since you know your insurance better than anyone, please make sure that if you are told by the doctor that you need additional testing, and you were not prepared, you may want to come back another day or call your insurance company first if you are not sure. You should always check with your insurance company to make sure whether or not you do or do not need a referral, need to pay an additional co-pay or be aware that it may go to your deductible.
