

Contact Lens Fitting Fees

The below fees are not covered by medical insurance. If you have a separate vision plan the fees may be discounted.

Check and Renewal (today's visit only): \$60

The following fees include 2 follow up visits. Subsequent follow up visits with incur additional charges:

Basic Refitting:	\$90	Specialty Refit (Toric/Multifocal):	\$120
Basic New Fit:	\$150	Specialty New Fit (Toric/Multifocal):	\$200

Refraction Fee

A refraction is the process of determining if there is a need for corrective eyeglasses, or a change in the eyeglass prescription. It is NOT a covered service by Medicare or most medical insurance plans. These plans consider refraction a "vision" service, not a "medical" service. Our office fee for refraction is separate from your insurance co-payment. We appreciate your payment today. <u>There may not be a change in your prescription, however, if we do the refraction we have to charge for it.</u> If you elect to proceed with the refraction we will submit the charge on your behalf to your insurance carrier. Should any portion of the refraction be covered by your insurance carrier you will be reimbursed.
